



Hollywood PAL College Scholarship Requirements

Who can apply:

- A current or past (within last 3 years) Hollywood PAL participant
- Graduating high school seniors with minimum 2.0 GPA.
- PAL Alumni who received a scholarship during their freshman year of college, (preference will be given to first year college students)

The Award:

- Can range from \$500 to \$2,000, based on financial need and academic merit
- Student will receive first half of their award within two months of being notified of their scholarship. He/she must submit grades and receipts after the first half of the school year to receive the second half of his/her award for the school year. If the student does not meet the 2.5 GPA requirement, he/she must meet for an interview with the scholarship committee to determine the circumstances and whether or not the second half of the award will be given to the student.

Checklist

- Hollywood PAL Application Form
- Essay
- A copy of Student Aid Report (SAR)
- Copies of other forms of financial aid applied for and/or awarded
- Certified copy of your grades from your high school or college
- Financial Need Letter from parents or guardian AND/OR a Letter of Recommendation from adult non-relative, non-PAL Officer

Instructions

- All of the items on the above checklist need to be in the PAL office by **Friday, June 9th at midnight. No exceptions.** Applications should be emailed (kgordillo@hollywoodpal.org) or hand delivered (6501 Fountain Avenue).
- Fill out the form **COMPLETELY** in ink or on a computer (you can download the application from www.hollywoodpal.org).
- The Financial Need Letter should be no more than 250 words and should be written by your parent or guardian. This is an opportunity for them to explain how much they will be able to financially contribute to your education and bring to our attention any additional financial burdens that are not otherwise addressed on the application. (Examples: Death in the family, elderly or handicapped relatives living in the home, etc.)
- The Letter of Recommendation should be written by an adult, but not a relative or PAL Officer. No word count restrictions.
- We expect that you write your essay in a clear, concise manner. There is not a page or word minimum or restriction. Answer the question completely and to the best of your ability. A typed essay is preferred. If it is handwritten, it must be in ink and legible.
- All answers and information provided are kept confidential.
