The Hollywood PAL Celebrity Bowl Fundraiser boasts that all proceeds go directly to support the PAL programs. Everything is donated from the food to the trophies, thanks to PAL's incredible partners. Terri Tilton, PAL Board Member and Chair of the Bowling event, says, "This event provides an opportunity for our community and celebrities to interact with our PAL kids and LAPD, thus gaining a greater understanding of Hollywood PAL, our purpose and the youth that we serve."

Tickets for this popular event are limited and are currently available at \$600 for a Kingpin Sponsorship, which includes bowling for 6 to 8 individuals, one drink ticket per person, a bottle of champagne, and one voucher for a free Red Pin Bowling Party for a future visit. Individual tickets will be available 1 month prior to the event, \$50 for individual bowlers and \$25 for spectators.
